4	(a) WITHDRAWAL.—Subject to subsection (b), the			
5	Valle Vidal Unit of the Carson National Forest in New			
6	Mexico, which consists of 101,794 acres and is identified			
7	as Management Area 21 in the land and resource manage-			
8	ment plan for the Carson National Forest, is hereby with-			
9	drawn from—			
10	(1) all forms of entry, appropriation, and dis-			
11	posal under the public land laws;			
12	(2) location, entry, and patent under the mining			
13	laws; and			
14	(3) operation of the mineral leasing and geo-			
15	thermal leasing laws and mineral materials laws.			
16	(b) Treatment of Existing Rights.—The with-			
17	drawal required by subsection (a) is subject to valid exist-			
18	ing rights. If these existing rights are relinquished or oth-			
19	erwise acquired by the United States at any time after			
20	the date of the enactment of this Act, the lands that were			
21	subject to the rights shall be immediately withdrawn as			
22	provided in subsection (a).
